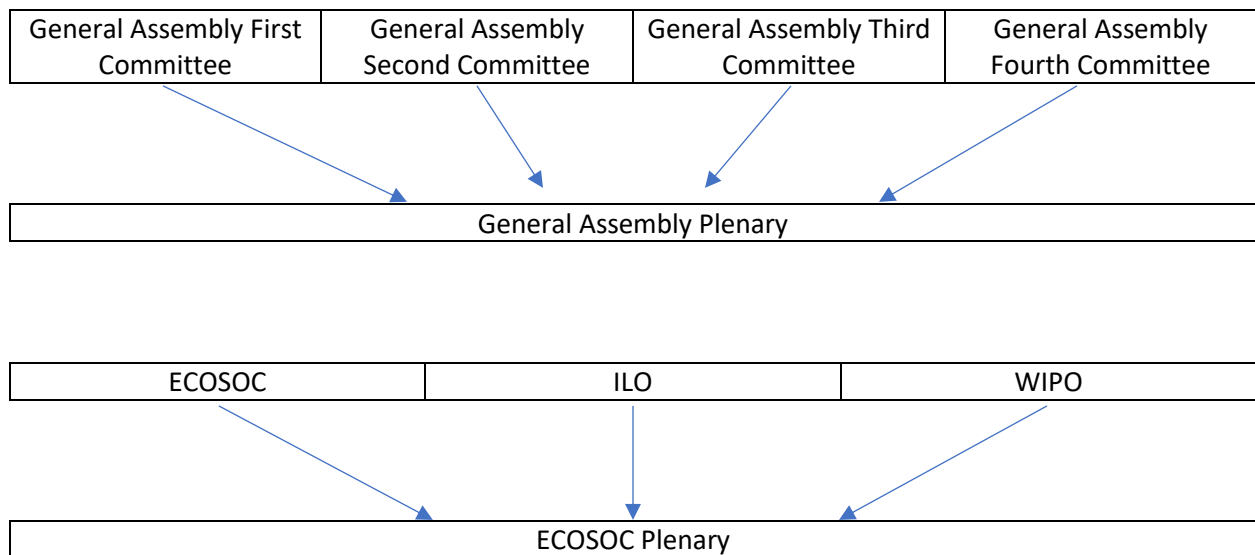

Delegates will have until Thursday evening to pass a draft resolution in their own committee.

### Plenary Sessions

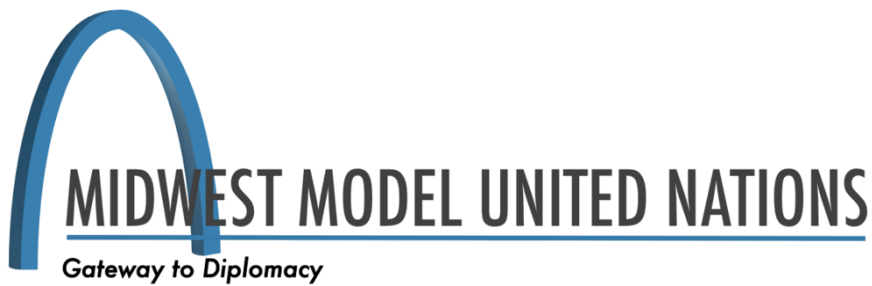
This segment will host plenary committees for the General Assembly and ECOSOC. In the General Assembly plenary, delegates from the four General Assembly committees will represent their country in one large session. Likewise, during ECOSOC plenary, delegates from ECOSOC, ILO, and WIPO will represent their country in one large session.



For example, the delegates who represented Finland in GAs 1, 2, 3, and 4 on Wednesday and Thursday, will now sit at one placard and represent Finland for the General Assembly plenary on Friday and Saturday. The plenary sessions will deliberate on draft resolutions that were passed by the sub-committees under its jurisdiction, and consider whether or not to pass them as resolutions. 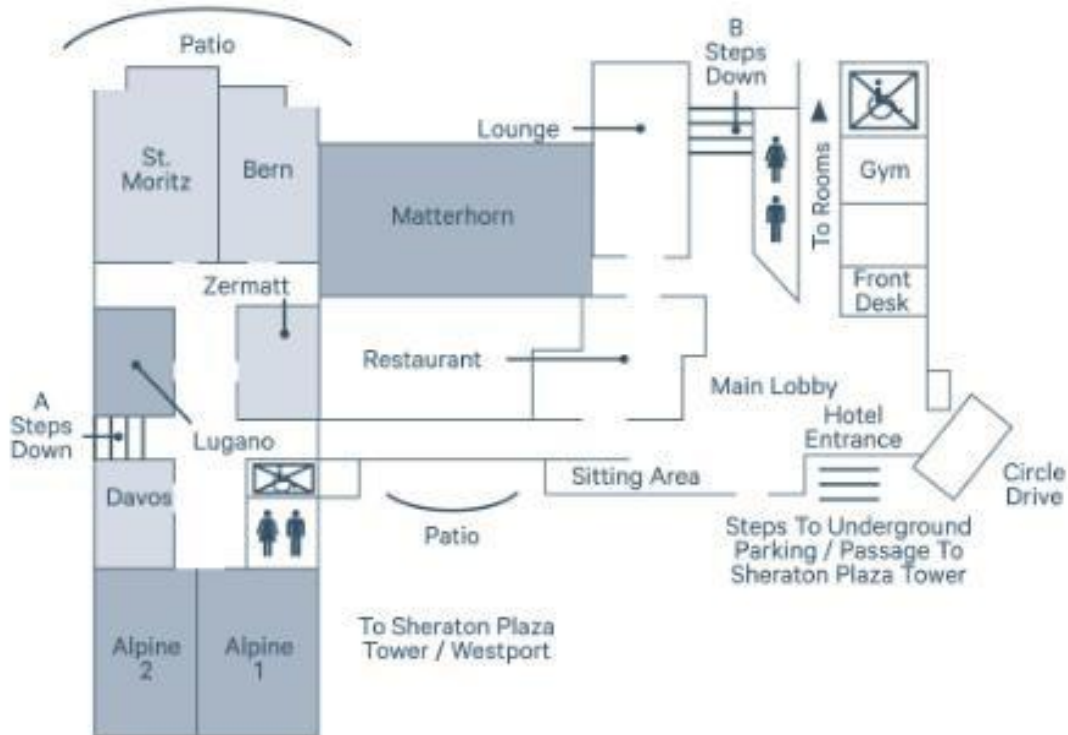
